

Troop Service Chair Volunteer Ministry Description

Purpose: Support the mission of AHG to build women of integrity by planning service projects for the Troop, fostering the girls' love for serving others and provide opportunities to put their faith into action.

Reports To: Troop Coordinator

Responsibilities:

General:

- Pray for the Charter Organization, the Troop's Adult and Girl Members, and the AHG Ministry.
- Model spiritual leadership by intentionally including prayer and Scripture when serving.
- Collaborate with the Troop Ministry Team to plan the annual Troop Calendar.
- Adhere to AHG Health and Safety Policies and Guidelines.
- Attend regular Troop meetings, activities, and events.
- Coordinate with Troop Ministry Team to promote AHG in the local community.
- Set the expectation for uniforms and model correct uniform at all AHG Meetings, events, and activities.

Role Specific:

- Work with girls and Unit Leaders to identify service opportunities that the girls are passionate about.
- Collaborate with the Troop Board to serve the Charter Organization at least once annually.
- Plan age-appropriate service projects allowing every girl the opportunity to serve.
- Facilitate opportunities for girls to lead service projects.
- Network within the community and other ministries to identify new service opportunities.

Qualifications:

- Registered AHG Adult Member, at least 21 years old.
- Maintain your personal relationship with Jesus Christ and be an effective witness for Him.
- Active and regular participation in a local church, small group, and/or similar gathering to grow in your relationship with Jesus Christ and fellowship with other believers.
- A positive, Christ-like attitude with a passion for growing the AHG Ministry.
- Serve as an example and live by the AHG Oath, Creed, Mission, and Statement of Faith.
- Commitment to teamwork and Biblical conflict resolution.
- Preferred strengths: humility, compassion, organization.

Required training prior to the first Troop meeting*:

- BEST Practices: Health and Safety Quick Guide



* Any training required by state law when interacting with youth

Weekly Commitment: Approximately 1-2 hours a week.
